Course description

With this **French language course for beginners**, you will have the chance to learn proper French and get an insight into the rich French culture.

You will be able to observe **different teaching methods** and broaden your understanding of your profession.

The course includes morning language lessons tailored to your skill level and needs, whether you are a **complete beginner** or have some prior knowledge.

By the end of this course, you will have gained a deeper understanding of the **French language and culture** through firsthand experiences and guidance from local professional tutors.

You will leave with new tools to enhance your teaching skills, a fresh perspective on your profession, and the ability to compare different learning and teaching methods.



Please note: we offer two more sessions in the afternoon on Tuesday and Thursday and also one workshop on Wednesday.

Learning outcomes

The course will help the participants to:

- Enhance their speaking and listening skills in French;
- Build a foundation for understanding and using basic French grammar and vocabulary;
- Develop their confidence in using the French language in everyday situations;
- Gain an introduction to French culture, including customs and traditions;
- Acquire hands-on experience in practicing their language skills through interactive activities and exercises.

Tentative schedule

Day 1 - Course introduction

- Course and weekly activity overview;
- Getting to know the school and fellow participants;
- Greetings, introducing yourself (name, nationality, profession);
- Basic classroom vocabulary and instructions;
- Setting individual learning goals.

Day 2 - Everyday basics

- Grammar: present tense of regular -er verbs, subject pronouns;
- Vocabulary: numbers, days, months, polite expressions;
- Speaking: asking/answering basic questions (Where are you from? What do you do?);
- Listening: short dialogues (introductions, asking for something);
- Pair practice: structured mini-conversations.

Day 3 - Talking about yourself and others



- Grammar: être, avoir, gender and articles (un/une/le/la);
- Vocabulary: family, nationalities, hobbies;
- Speaking: describing people and giving basic details;
- Writing: filling out a basic form, and writing short sentences.

Day 4 - Basic grammar and conversation for beginners

- Grammar: basic questions (où, quand, comment...), singular/plural nouns;
- Vocabulary: places in town, transport, food and drink;
- Speaking: ordering in a café, asking for directions;
- Roleplay: everyday dialogues.

Day 5 - Reinforce grammar concepts and conversation for beginners

- Grammar: review of key points from the week;
- Vocabulary: survival phrases for travel and daily life;
- Speaking: short guided conversations and roleplays;
- Group activity: performing a mini-dialogue;
- Final discussion: how to continue learning French.

Day 6 - Course closure and cultural activities

- Course evaluation: round-up of acquired competencies, feedback, and discussion;
- Awarding of the course Certificate of Attendance;
- Excursion and other external cultural activities.
